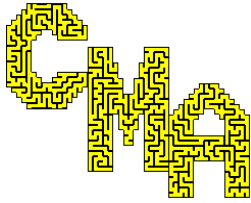

Our lowest cost option allows you to cut the maze yourself using a cutting method based off a grid system that does not require any computer equipment. These farms only have the cost of the maze design. But some farms want more assistance from our professional staff, so we are happy to cut your maze for you. While this method does have more costs, we put our high tech equipment and skilled staff to work so that you will have a maze that looks just as great in the field as it does on paper.

Once the maze is cut, you are now ready to maintain and operate a successful maze.
